## **Checklist for AB5 Exemptions**

This is a checklist of freelancers' exemptions from AB5/AB2257/Article 1.5. Yes, it's bureaucratic and annoying, but we need to be exempt. For that, you must satisfy *all the criteria for one exemption plus some of the criteria for Borello*.
